You should be aware that Bordeaux can and will shed and drool profusely. You should be aware that Bordeaux can have health problems common to giant breed dogs despite health testing. If you have purchased a puppy for show we require that you inform us of titles earned and health screens performed. It is important that you understand that the acquisition of one of our puppies is a commitment for the lifetime of the dog and you may NOT re-home or otherwise place on of our puppies. If you cannot continue to care for this dog for any reason, the dog MUST be returned to us.
